## FREE ACCOMMODATION TO ALL PLAYERS

### 1. Invitation:

Buldana Zilha Chess Circle has the honour to invite all Chess Players from the State of Maharashtra to participate in the Buldana Urban Maharashtra State Under 17 Open & Girls FIDE Rating Selection Chess Championship 2023

### 2. Recognition:

The championship is held under the auspices of All India Chess Federation, Maharashtra Chess Association & Organised By Buldana Zilha Chess Circle and will serve as selection event for the National Under 17 Open and Girls Chess Championship.

### 3. Eligibility Criteria:

Only the players apt in to the following conditions are eligible to play the said chess championship.

- ◆ Born on and after - 01-01-2006.
- ◆ All entries should be strictly routed through the respective District Chess Associations affiliated to MCA.
- ◆ Each district association is entitled to field 2 players in Open & 2 in Girls the respective categories.
- ◆ Selected Player' means the player selected from the respective District selection championships. Besides

the above, the District Associations may enter an unlimited number of players as a donor entry.

- ◆ In addition to the above, three additional entries for the districts which won Gold, two additional entries for the districts which won Silver and one additional entry for the districts which won Bronze Medal at the State U-17 Open and Girls Chess Championship 2022 held in Pune.
- ◆ Open – Pune (Gold and Silver) – 5 entries; Solapur (Bronze) – 1 entry  
Girls –Pune (Gold) – 3 entries; Akola (Silver) – 2 entries; Sangli (Bronze) – 1 entry

#### 4.Exemption Criteria:

Participation in the state selection chess tournaments of Maharashtra is mandatory for everyone except for certain exemptions who can directly give their entry for respective national tournament which are mentioned below:

No.	Tournament	Criteria
1	State Senior Open Selection	Players with classical rating of 2000 and above exempted from participation
2	State Senior Women Selection	Players with classical rating of 1600 and above exempted from participation
3	State Junior (U19) Open Selection	Players with classical rating of 1900 and above exempted from participation
4	State Junior (U19) Girls Selection	Players with classical rating of 1500 and above exempted from participation
5	State Under 17 Open Selection	Players with classical rating of 1800 and above exempted from participation
6	State Under 17 Girls Selection	Players with classical rating of 1500 and above exempted from participation
7	State Sub Junior (U15) Open Selection	Players with classical rating of 1600 and above exempted from participation
8	State Sub Junior (U15) Girls Selection	Players with classical rating of 1400 and above exempted from participation
9	State Under 13 Open & Girls Selection	Players with classical rating of 1400 and above exempted from participation
10	State Under 11 Open & Girls Selection	Compulsory for everyone
11	State Under 9 Open & Girls Selection	Compulsory for everyone
12	State Under 7 Open & Girls Selection	Compulsory for everyone

If any player wishes to skip the state selection championships and directly take part in national championships then he/she will have to pay privilege fee of Rs. 3,500 to MCA for each state selection championship which they desire to skip. It is mandatory for any player to take part in at least one state selection chess championship for he/she to be exempted from paying the privilege fee in current year. Any decision taken by the Hon. Gen. Secretary of Maharashtra Chess Association regarding entry under the privilege fee scheme will be treated as final.

## 5. Selection of Maharashtra Team:

- ◆ Top 2 Boys And Top 2 Girls From Each Age Group Will Be Selected To Represent Maharashtra State In Forthcoming National Chess Championship For The Same Age Group. Players Participating In This Championship Will Only Be Allowed To Participate In National Chess Championship. (top 4 For Junior / Senior / Senior / Women).
- ◆ Participation In This Championship Is Compulsory If Any Player Wishes To Take Part In National Championship.

## 6. Date Of Birth Certificates:

Each Participant Must Produce A Valid Certificate To Prove His/her Age. School Id Card / Aadhar Card Won't Be Accepted As Dob Proof. Certificates Should Preferably Be From The Panchayat, Municipality Or Corporation Obtained Soon After Birth. Players Without Date Of Birth Certificates Will Not Be Allowed To Participate.

- ◆ The Date Of Birth Certificates Registered Within One Year Of The Birth Of The Child Alone Will Be Recognized And Allowed To Participate.
- ◆ If Any Doubt Arises About The Claimed Age Of A Player, The Tournament Committee Has The Right To Refer The Player During The Championship For A Due Evaluation Of Age By Competent Medical Experts. A Player If Declared Over-age By Such Experts Shall Not Continue In The Championship And The Matter Shall Be Reported To Aicf. Protest About The Age Of Players May Be Made To The Chief Arbiter In Writing Along With A Fee Of 5000/- Per Player. This Will Not Be Refunded. No Protest About Over Age Of A Player Will Be Entertained After 2nd Round Of The Championship.

(Regulations regarding registration for AICF may be altered in the future but registration is mandatory)

## 10.System Of Play:

Tournament Will Be Played With 8 Rounds Swiss System. The Format May Be Changed To Emergency Cases With The Discretion Of Chief Arbiter & Tournament Director With Prior Approval From Mca & Aicf.

- ◆ Time control will be 60 minutes + 30 seconds increment from move 1.

## 11.Tiebreaks:

- ◆ Buchholz Cut 1.
- ◆ Buchholz.
- ◆ SB.
- ◆ Direct Encounter.
- ◆ Greater number of wins (including forfeit points).
- ◆ Greater number of wins with black.

## 12.Appeals:

- ◆ The Chief Arbiter's Decision will be final & binding to all. In case of any discrepancy, the matter will be handed over to Appeals Committee which will be formed during the Players' meeting before the start of First Round.
